

Duration: The access provided by a single license lasts for three consecutive years. This extended period ensures that students can continue to benefit from digital learning resources for an extended duration.

Sponsorship: The initiative allows Rotary districts or clubs to sponsor students' participation in the program by contributing Rs. 1,000 per student. This sponsorship model is designed to make the program more accessible to students who might not have the financial means to afford such resources on their own.

Market Value: The scholarship program claims that the market value of each scholarship, in terms of the access provided through the app, is approximately Rs. 80,000. This implies that the initiative aims to offer high-quality educational content at a significantly reduced cost to the students.

The program shares a success story from Baharu Girls High School in Joynagar, South 24 Parganas. According to the school's gratitude letter, students who benefitted from the Lakshya Scholarship and used the "Think and Learn Premium app" showed improved learning concepts and better results.

Achievements: The Lakshya scholarship and E-Shiksha-For-All initiatives combined have impacted the lives of 276 students from various states in India in July 2023, including West Bengal, Odisha, Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, and Maharashtra. This highlights the broad reach of the program and its ability to touch students from different regions.

Overall, the E-Shiksha - For all initiative appears to build upon the success of the Lakshya scholarship by providing students across India with access to digital learning resources through the Think & Learn Premium app. This initiative aims to bridge educational gaps and empower students to improve learning outcomes.
