

determination, had come forward to be part of this noble mission.



with the responsibility of managing a small shop to make ends meet. The financial situation was tough, and her mother had to work tirelessly to support the family.

Despite the hardships, Bithi recognized the paramount importance of education and her desire to contribute to her family's well-being. She completed her studies in Siliguri and embarked on a relentless search for job opportunities. However, her journey was fraught with numerous obstacles and disappointments, with some individuals seeking to take advantage of her vulnerable situation.

In her quest for a solution, Bithi stumbled upon the Bandhan Skill Development Centre (BSDC) in Siliguri through an online search. Impressed by the positive feedback from students, she decided to visit the center and ultimately enrolled herself.

Initially shy and reserved, Bithi found herself in the capable hands of trainers at the Siliguri BSDC, who provided her with invaluable guidance and support to develop her skills and confidence.

She successfully attended an interview at Kutchina and secured a job at the Hakimpara Unit in Siliguri. During her probation period, she earns a commendable Rs 8.2k/month with incentives. After three months, her salary will be revised, and she will also be entitled to other statutory benefits such as PF, ESIC, and an annual bonus.

This achievement not only empowers Bithi to support her family financially but also enables her to bear the expenses of her sister's education. Bithi's story is a shining example of the transformative power of skill development and the positive impact it can have on an individual's life.
